As most of you know, it is the dreaded sickness season. Please remember our sickness policy is put in place for a reason. Children **MUST** be **SYMPTOM FREE** for 24 hours. To keep other students and our staff healthy, **PLEASE** we can't say it enough keep your child home if they:

- **Have a fever of 101 or more within the last 24 hours.**
- **If your child has NOT been fever free for 24 hours.**
- **If your child is vomiting**
- **If your child has diarrhea**
- **If your child has a communicable disease i.e.; strep, pink eye, mercer, impetigo). (CONTACT CENTER ASAP)**
- **If your child has Lice. (Must be NIT Free to return)**
- **Hand, Foot, & Mouth**



Inclement Winter Weather

In case of inclement weather during the winter, be assured that staff at Nature's Scholars make every effort possible to get the center open on time. At the discretion of the Director/Administrator, the center may have to be closed due to dangerous conditions. If this were to occur before 6:00am the voicemail message will be changed to indicate a closing along with a posting on our Facebook page and an email sent out. If any of the following conditions occur during the school day, a phone call will be made indicating that we will need to close. Those conditions could be, but are not limited to... ice, snowfall, loss of power for an extended amount of time, loss of water or insufficient quality and more.

We do not automatically close if area schools close. We understand that some parents **MUST** be at their place of work at times. We are here for those parental emergencies and do not promote taking your child out if not necessary during dangerous weather conditions.

This year we are continuing our Whoville Celebration Day! After a morning of Whoville themed activities, and a visit from Santa, we will be watching the Grinch at naptime.

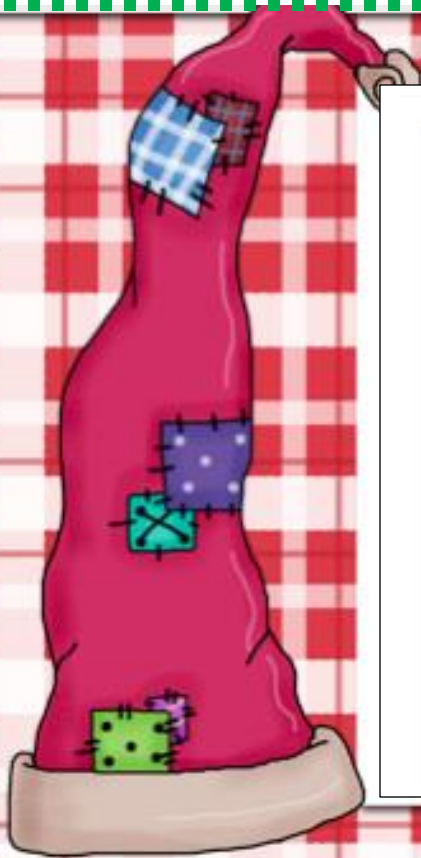
Chase's 6th Annual Lego & Christmas Toy Drive for Children's Hospital of Wisconsin!
