Parent Handbook Review

What type of clothing needs to be available for outdoor play?

All children will be going outside everyday snow, rain or shine unless weather is extremely prohibitive. (Due to staff/child ratio requirements, children may not be kept indoors and should remain home if unable to go outside.) Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

Waterproof coat, mittens, hats, snow pants, boots, etc. are needed for cold or wet days. A swimsuit and towel need to be brought to school on warm days for outdoor/water play. **Our guideline for outdoors in the winter is 0 degrees or above with the wind chill in consideration.** Our guideline for outdoors in the summer is 95 degrees or below.

Children will remain in the airconditioned center if any ozone or heat indexes are issued for immediate area. Special considerations of high and low temperatures will be in place for infants, toddlers and special needs children.
