

Off-site field trips for the Frontiers, Rangers & OG will need chaperones and the extra attending students do not need an adult to attend with them. Those classrooms will have a slightly higher activity fee. In addition to the in-house special quests, those three classrooms will include 3 additional off-site field trips, t-shirt and materials for special projects and experiments.
